- 5 maxillary molars
- 5 mandibular molars
- 10 Mix of maxillary and mandibular anterior and bicuspid teeth

Not all the extracted teeth you gather will be of the quality necessary to complete these projects and if remediation is required to complete the homework, lab projects or competency, you'll need additional teeth to those listed above so please prepare accordingly.

Plan on collecting **SIGNIFICANTLY MORE** extracted teeth than the bare minimum listed above.

It is not rare for students, when screening teeth, to only find 10% of gathered teeth are acceptable for use in the endo labs.

Additionally, this list reflects the teeth gathering needs for the endodontic department as of 8.25.2021 but such may change by the time you take the course listed above (in your D2, D3 and D4 years).

Teeth must be turned in “at least” 2 weeks before class to Alisa Wilson for sterilization.

Submit teeth in a plastic (screw lid) container, (teeth may be stored in Chlorhexadine or Formalin) with your full name and your LLU email.

Once the teeth are processed you will receive an email for pick up.
