1. TB skin tests - no more than 2 years old
2. Chest x-rays - no more than 2 years old **ONLY** if TB skin test reads positive
3. Hepatitis B- current titer no more than 1 year old
4. Flu shot, Tdap, MMR, Varicella
5. CPR card
6. Current US dental license
- *7. Continuing Dental Education requirement for non-California license holders – See page 2.

Please note: You must show proof of all of the above to treat any patient of Loma Linda University School of Dentistry. Any patient treated through the LLUSD & any hands-on program must become a patient-of-record of Loma Linda University School of Dentistry.

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Additional Information:

* Continuing Dental Education requirement for non-California license holders.

Dentists and allied dental professionals that hold a non-California license (another state or country) must submit documents that demonstrate compliance with the current license renewal requirements for a California license, as identified in the Title 16 California Code of Regulations Sections 1016 and 1017:

- The minimum requirement for each two-year renewal period after the first renewal is 50 hours of continuing education, including:
 - Basic Life Support
 - 2 hours of California Infection Control
 - 2 hours of California Dental Practice Act
