### Undergraduate College Requirements

It is recommended that applicants complete four years at an accredited college or university. However, exceptional students may be eligible to apply after completion of a three year pre-dentistry curriculum.

**A complete academic year of classwork (8 semester or 12 quarter units) in the following courses are required within 5 years prior to admission:**

- Freshman English (complete course)
- General Physics (with lab)
- General Biology or Zoology (with lab)
- Organic Chemistry (with lab)
- Religion (as required by the college)
- General Chemistry (with lab)
- Biochemistry (2 Quarters or 1 Semester)
- Electives
